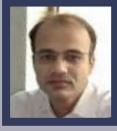

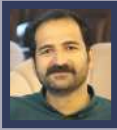

Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering and Information Technology (KFUEIT) is a public sector university located in Rahim Yar Khan. The university was established with the vision of promoting higher education, research, and technological advancement in South Punjab.

The institution was founded in 2014 by the Government of Punjab to address the growing need for quality education in engineering, information technology, and applied sciences in the region. It was named after the renowned Sufi poet Khwaja Ghulam Fareed, reflecting a blend of cultural heritage and modern scientific education.

KFUEIT was developed on the foundation of an already existing technical education setup, which helped accelerate its initial academic operations. From the beginning, the university focused on offering undergraduate programs in core disciplines such as engineering, computer science, and natural sciences.

Over time, the university expanded rapidly by introducing new

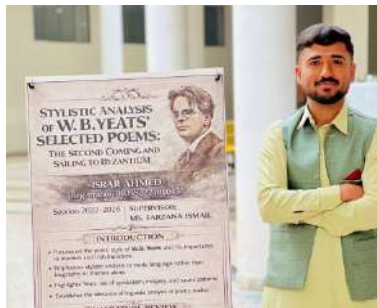
Post Evaluation Thesis Exhibition Showcases Student Brilliance by Institute of Humanities & Arts

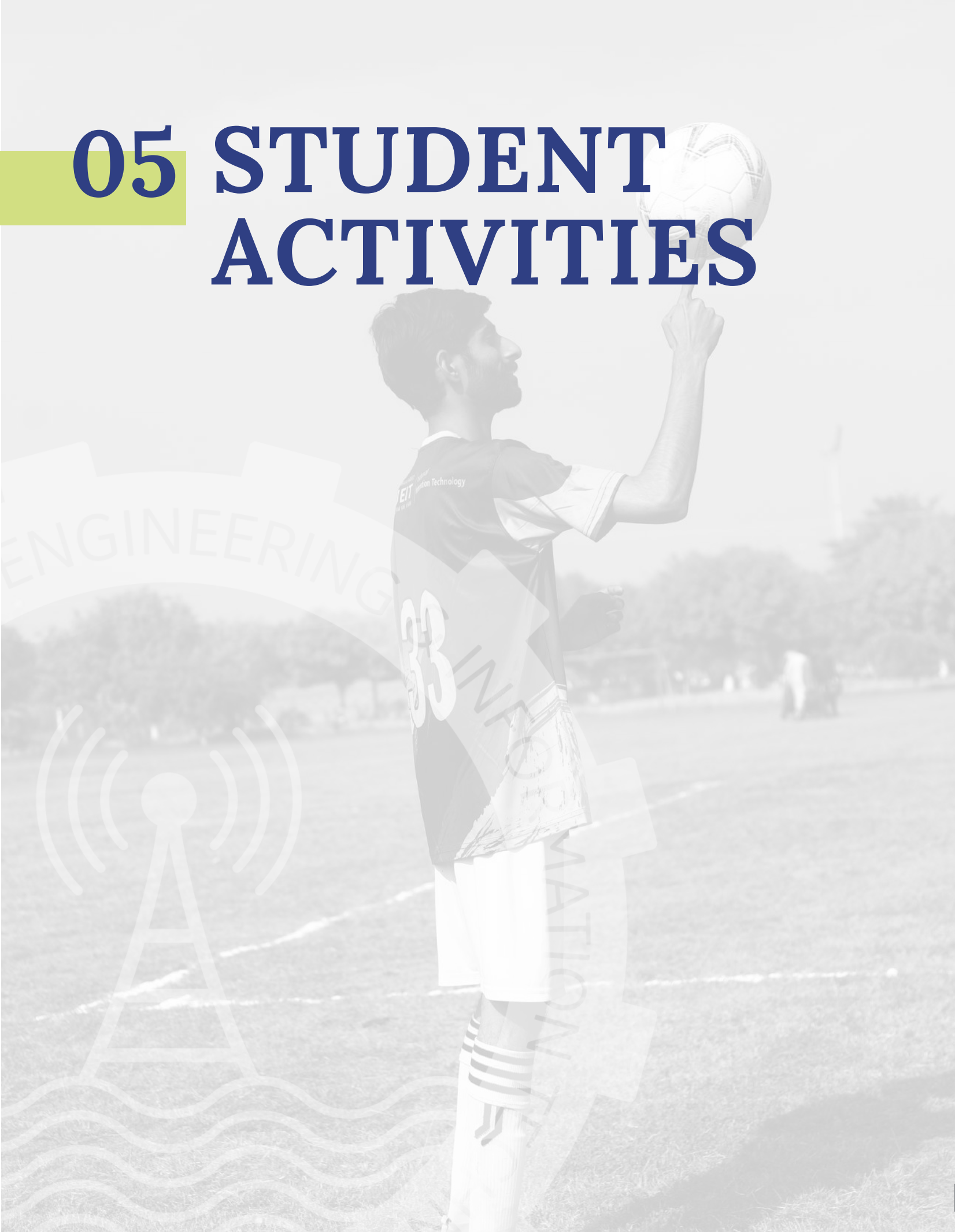
